



Information about language modules for students in the BPO E 2016/2020 and BPO L 2016/2019

Bachelor's degree program in nutritional sciences

For the module **ESK 3 Schlüsselkompetenzen**, the module **ESK 3.10 Erweiterung der Fremdsprachenkompetenz** can be selected as a 3-credit module. To do this, choose from the language center's (Sprachenzentrum) following offerings:

- Business English – general business English, Stufe B2
- Intercultural Business Skills, Stufe B2
- Advanced Discussion Skills, Stufe B2/C1
- Mastering Global Dialogue
- Fremdsprachenvertiefung – Fachsprache für Ernährungswissenschaften, Stufe B2
- Foreign language that is not your native language and is not English at level A1

The language courses are each completed with a certificate.

Bachelor's degree program in food science

For the module **Wahlmodul L6.2**, the module **W2 Erweiterung der Fremdsprachenkompetenz** can be chosen. This consists of two language courses (two 3 credit points) from the following offerings from the language center (Sprachenzentrum):

1. Business English – Angebote zur englischen Geschäftssprache, Stufe B 2
2. Fachsprache für den Bereich Lebensmittelwissenschaft, Stufe B 2,
3. or another foreign language from the language center's offerings other than your own mother tongue.

The language courses are each completed with a graded exam.



Course registration, examination, and transmission of the examination result

You can use offers from both locations. These are free of charge for you.

 - blocks during the lecture period,
 - blocks during the lecture-free period – holiday courses.
- Please register via the course catalog of the Language Center (Sprachzentrum) MG or KR in HiO.
 - For all language courses you must take a placement test. You will receive the link to this test after you register. At the end of the course you will take part in the exam in accordance with the conditions of the course (you can find information there).
 - For the course to be recognized as an ESK or Wahlmodul in your study plan, submit a copy of the passed examination to Ms. Brucks in the student office, room O 109. Please submit the original at the same time.
 - You can freely choose the semester in which you take the courses.
 - If you take more language courses than you need for the modules of your studies, please indicate in a timely manner and clearly which ones should be counted towards your language module.
