

## **Information sheet on internships in Bangladesh**

The short internships in Bangladesh are designed to give students a direct and personal impression of the textile and clothing industry in one of the most important producing countries for textiles and clothing. The aim is for students to see and experience first-hand the everyday working life, occupational safety, social and environmental standards, and living conditions of the people in the country. In the past, the short internships were planned for a duration of approximately four weeks during the semester breaks, i.e. for the periods February/March and July/August/September. The partner university Bangladesh University of Fashion and Technology (BUFT) provided support in organising the internship placements and local companies. Up to eight students could live together in an apartment rented by the department and were driven daily by drivers to the internship companies in the Dhaka area. Unfortunately, this accommodation is no longer available. Suitable accommodation must first be found for future interns. One or two vehicles with drivers will also be needed for the trips between the internship company and the place of residence.

If you decide to apply, please ensure that you enclose all the documents requested in the form. In the past, we have regularly received far more applications than there were places available. In this case, the order in which applications are received is used to allocate internship places. However, applicants who are not successful will not be carried over to the following semester. Students must reapply for each semester.
