To be admitted to a German-taught degree programme at the HSNR, applicants are required to prove their German language proficiency.

HSNR accepts the following language certificates:

- Test DaF (Test Deutsch als Fremdsprache) at least level 3 in every unit
- Deutsche Sprachprüfung für den Hochschulzugang (DSH 1)
- telc Deutsch B2
- Goethe Zertifikat B2
- B2-certificate of attendance - after having successfully completed HSNR's German preparatory language course for university studies
