



## Funding rates ERASMUS+ grants for stays in the 2025/2026 funding period

The rates are determined according to country groups classified by the European Commission and according to the Erasmus Call (contract) specified by the university.

The funding year may differ from the academic year.

## International Office



The minimum funding period for internships and study visits is 2 months (60 working days). For short stays, 5 days in attendance.

From Call 2025 onwards, travel will be supported with a travel allowance based on distance (see table) and, if applicable, travel days between 1-2 days (exception: stays within commuting distance). Green travel will be financially supported with up to 6 additional days (daily rate) – tickets must be submitted. The information will be checked after the end of the stay.

Participants with fewer opportunities\* can apply for a top-up of 250 €/month directly in the application tool (Mobility Online). For short-term stays or blended mobility, the top-up is calculated as follows:

Stays of up to 14 days = 100 € one-off payment Stays of 15 days or more = 150 € one-off payment Travel allowance based on distance = one-off payment

Please refer to the information sheet "Additional funding" for the guidelines on how to apply. 70% of the grant will be transferred before the stay abroad, and 100% of the FO grants will be transferred.

Approval of the grant is subject to the obligation to submit all necessary documents – both before, during and after the stay abroad – in a timely manner.

If this does not happen, the Niederrhein University of Applied Sciences may withhold the grant payment or reclaim amounts already paid out.

The remaining grant will be paid out after all relevant documents have been submitted and is based on the actual academic duration of the internship or studies.

The academic stay at a partner university may include:

- 1.) Mandatory quarantine in the host country before the start of studies
- 2.) Welcome day(s)
- 3.) Preparatory language courses (prior application)
- 4.) Face-to-face lectures and examinations
