

Funding rates for ERASMUS+ grants for stays during the funding periods 2025/2026 and 2026/27

The rates are determined according to country groups as classified by the European Commission and according to the Erasmus Call (contract) specified by the university.

The funding year may differ from the academic year.

The minimum funding period for work placements and study visits is 2 months (60 working days, excluding travel days). For short-term stays, 5 days on-site. As a rule, 5 months (150 days) are estimated for the academic stay.

Travel is supported by a travel allowance based on distance (see table) and, where applicable, travel days of between 1 and 2 days (exception: stays within commuting distance). Green travel is supported with up to 6 additional days' financial support (daily rate) – tickets must be submitted. The details are checked before the start of the stay (for short-term stays) or after the end of the stay (for long-term stays).

Participants with fewer opportunities* can apply for a top-up of €250 per month directly via the application tool (Mobility Online). For short-term stays or blended mobility, the top-up is calculated as follows:

Stays of up to 14 days = €100 one-off payment
 Stays of 15 days or more = €150 one-off payment
 Travel allowance based on distance = one-off payment

 70% of the scholarship is paid before the stay abroad, whilst 100% of the FO grants are paid in advance.

Acceptance of the grant is subject to the obligation to submit all necessary documents – both before, during and after the stay abroad – by the specified deadlines.

*Students and graduates with a disability classified as GdB 20 or higher, or with a chronic illness

*Students and postgraduates undertaking their period abroad with children

*First-generation university students (students from non-academic backgrounds)

Should this not be done, the Hochschule Niederrhein may withhold the grant payment or reclaim amounts already paid out.

The remaining grant will be paid out upon submission of all relevant documents and will be based on the actual duration of the academic placement or study period.

The academic stay at a partner university may include:

- 1.) Mandatory quarantine in the host country prior to the start of studies
- 2.) Welcome day(s)
- 3.) Preparatory language courses (prior application required)
- 4.) Face-to-face lectures and examinations at the host institution
